

Camper Release Card

Each Camper must have a signed Camper Release Card on file with the Cub Scout Day Camp he/she is attending.

1. Camp Staff will release Campers only to an authorized person listed on this card.
2. The authorized person will be asked to show a photo ID (Drivers License, State ID, Military ID, etc.) before a camper can be released to them.
3. Campers arriving late or leaving early must check in/ check out at the Day Camp Headquarters.
4. If someone is not authorized to take a Camper, such as a non-custodial parent, the Camp Director for the site should be notified of this in writing.
5. **Under no circumstances is a camper to be dropped off and left alone at camp.**

Parents & Guardians: Please fill out the back of this card and return to the Camp Director or designee prior to the start of the Day Camp session your camper will be attending. Do not forget to list yourself or your spouse.
